


**PCA review**

The figure below shows the first two PCs of genome-wide data from 777 present-day people from West Eurasia, along with three ancient British people who lived 9000, 5000 and 4000 years ago (labeled stars, “BP” means “[years] Before Present”).



1. What can you infer about the relationship between each of the ancient people and present-day Europeans?
2. What does this figure suggest about the history of Britain, and the people living there, over the past ten thousand years?
